- (c) (1) In Wicomico and Somerset counties, [exclusive of the Manokin River,] any State resident holding a current tonging license may catch oysters on any leased oyster bottom if [he] THE STATE RESIDENT first obtains the written permission of the lessee of the leased oyster bottom.
- (2) A LESSEE OR A BONA FIDE REPRESENTATIVE OF A LESSEE WHO HAS WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE LESSEE IS NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE A TONGING LICENSE IN THE MANOKIN RIVER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 399

(House Bill 1153)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - State's Attorney - Salary
PG 303-82

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Prince George's County State's Attorney and the assistant State's attorney; providing that the fixed salary increase will be implemented in a definite step manner over a certain period of time; altering the number of deputy State's attorneys, principal assistant State's attorneys, and assistant State's attorneys in Prince George's County; relating generally to the Prince George's County State's Attorney's office; and providing that this Act does not affect the incumbent.
