  - (3) Provides adequate evidence that:
- (i) At the time the applicant was licensed in the other state, the applicant was qualified to take the examination that then was required by the laws of this State; and
- (ii) The applicant qualified for a license in the other state by passing an examination administered in that or any other state.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall waive the examination requirements of this subtitle for an applicant who:
- (1) Attains on the [federal licensing examination] FEDERATION LICENSING EXAMINATION a passing score as set by the Board under its rules and regulations; or
