RESTRICTIONS--OF--THIS--SUBSECTION-DO-NOT-APPLY-TO-NEW-UNITS CONSTRUCTED,-MANASED,-OPERATED,-DEVELOPED,-OR-SUBSIDIZED--BY A--LOCAL--HOUSING-AUTHORITY-AS-ESTABLISHED-UNDER-ARTICLE-44A

- (2) THE APPLICATION OF THE SERVICE RESTRICTIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION TO NEW UNITS CONSTRUCTED, MANAGED, OPERATED, DEVELOPED, OR SUBSIDIZED BY A LOCAL HOUSING AUTHORITY AS ESTABLISHED UNDER ARTICLE 44A MAY BE WAIVED BY THE COMMISSION UPON THE DETERMINATION THAT THE MOST-ENERGY EFFICIENT-UTILITY SYSTEMS-PRACTICABLE-WILL-BE-UTILIZED-IN THE BUILDING WILL RESULT IN A SUBSTANTIAL NET SAVING OF ENERGY USED BY THESE SYSTEMS OVER THE ENERGY SAVING THAT WOULD RESULT FROM INDIVIDUAL METERING.
- (c) In no event shall the owner, operator, or manager of a residential multiple occupancy building or shopping center impose on any occupancy unit or shopping center unit any utility cost except charges authorized by the Public Service Commission and actually imposed by the utility upon the owner, operator, or manager.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1982.

(House Bill 1449)
