- (1) THE RESEARCHER STATES IN WRITING TO THE OFFICIAL CUSTODIAN THE PURPOSE OF THE RESEARCH, INCLUDING ANY INTENT TO PUBLISH FINDINGS, THE NATURE OF THE PERSONAL RECORDS SOUGHT, AND THE SAFEGUARDS TO BE TAKEN TO PROTECT THE IDENTITIES OF THE SUBJECTS--OF-THE-PERSONAL-RECORDS PERSONS IN INTEREST;
- (2) THE RESEARCHER STATES THAT THE SUBJECTS-OF THE-PERSONAL-RECORDS PERSONS IN INTEREST WILL NOT BE CONTACTED WITHOUT THE APPROVAL AND MONITORING OF THE OFFICIAL CUSTODIAN;
- (3) THE PROPOSED SAFEGUARDS ARE ADEQUATE TO PREVENT THE IDENTITIES OF THE SUBJECTS--OF-THE-PERSONAL REGORDS PERSONS IN INTEREST FROM BEING KNOWN; AND
- (4) THE RESEARCHER EXECUTES AN AGREEMENT WITH THE AGENCY OR INSTRUMENTALITY WHICH INCORPORATES ADEQUATE SAFEGUARDS FOR PROTECTION OF THE SUBJECTS-OF-THE-PERSONAL RECORDS PERSONS IN INTEREST, DEFINES THE SCOPE OF THE RESEARCH PROJECT AND PROVIDES THAT FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THOSE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES A BREACH OF CONTRACT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 432

(House Bill 1483)

AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations - Information Practices

FOR the purpose of providing that the State Board of Examiners of Nurses shall delete the name of a licensee from certain lists under certain circumstances; repealing certain provisions relating to the confidentiality of records maintained by the Board of Examiners of Nurses; and making this Act contingent on the passage of another Act.
