Article - Health Occupations

[7-503.

- (a) (1) In this section, "confidential record" means any record of the Board that concerns and identifies a licensee, former licensee, or license applicant.
- (2) "Confidential record" does not include a record:
- $\hspace{1.5cm} \hbox{(i)} \hspace{0.2cm} \hbox{Of the successful completion of an examination;} \\$
 - (ii) Of a license issuance or renewal;
- (iii) That indicates that an individual is not licensed or was not licensed at a particular time; or
- (iv) Of a final decision of the Board under $\S\S$ 7-312 or 7-605 of this title.
 - (b) A confidential record is exempt from:
 - (1) Process; and
- (2) Disclosure under the "Public Information Act", Article 76A, § 1 et seq. of the Code.
 - (c) A confidential record is available to:
- (1) The members of the Board or its authorized employees;
- (2) The individual to whom the record relates or an authorized agent of that individual;
- (3) The parties to a proceeding held under §§ 7-312 or 7-605 of this title for the purpose of inspecting and copying it; and
- (4) A court for judicial review of a decision of the Board in a proceeding under $\S\S$ 7-312 or 7-605 of this title.
- (d) By written statement, an individual may waive the confidentiality provided for that individual under this section as to any designated record that relates to the individual.]
