SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1982, contingent on the passage of H.B. (2r1714) of 1982. Should that measure fail of enactment, the provisions of this Act are null and void without the need of further action by the General Assembly.
