SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That--the Supervisors--ef--Elections--shall--advertise--in--any--two newspapers--ef--general-circulation--in--the--proposed--area--on four--successive--weeks--prior--to--the--Special-Election--notice of--the--time--place--and--purpose--ef--the--election.---The Commission--shall--provide--that,--at--the--special-election--a vote--shall--be--taken--on--the--names--ef--the--Aldermen--to represent--the--new--wards,--who--shall--take--office--in--the--event the--majority--of--the--votes--are--east--"For--Annexation"--.---The Commission--shall--prescribe--the--rules--and--procedure--for Aldermen--candidates--to--be--placed--upon--said--ballot. Aldermen--in--the--event--they--take--office,--shall--hold--the positions--until--the--next--regular--election--for--Mayor--and Aldermen--ef--Annapolis.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all meetings of the Commission shall be public. The Commission shall provide reasonable notice of the time and place of the meetings and shall keep a journal of the proceedings. The expenses of the Commission shall be borne equally by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis and by Anne Arundel County, Maryland. The Commission shall provide adequate opportunity for the public to comment on the progress of its work, its findings, on its recommendations, and all other facets of its work.

SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
