(III) WHEN TRANSPORTING ANY CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE, SHALL COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (A)(3), (4), (5), AND (6) OF THIS SECTION AND ALL APPLICABLE STATE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- If a person who generates a controlled hazardous substance desires to have it transported to a controlled hazardous substance facility, the person:
- (3) Shall require evidence of a hauler certificate, A DRIVER CERTIFICATE, and a vehicle certificate;
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

## CHAPTER 440

(House Bill 1560)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County Housing Opportunities Commissioners - Public Hearing Interview MC 269-82

FOR the purpose of requiring a public hearing interview prior to the appointment and removal of each commissioner to the Montgomery County Housing Opportunities Commission appointed after a certain date; and generally clarifying the appointment and removal procedures of each commissioner to the Housing Opportunities Commission.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 44A - Housing Authorities Section 8A(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1980 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 44A - Housing Authorities
