CHAPTER 449

(House Bill 1644)

AN ACT concerning

State Ethics Commission - Disclosure of Businesses

FOR the purpose of providing for the compilation by the State Ethics Commission of certain businesses doing business with the State.

BY adding to

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law Section 3-108 Annotated Code of Maryland (1978 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 40A - Maryland Public Ethics Law

3-108.

- (A) THE COMMISSION SHALL COMPILE ANNUALLY AN ALPHABETICAL LIST OF EACH BUSINESS ENTITY DOING BUSINESS WITH THE STATE, AS DEFINED IN $\S-1-201(E)(1)$ AND (2) OF THIS ARTICLE, DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.
- (B) THE LIST SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION NO LATER THAN MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR, AND THE COMMISSION SHALL MAKE INFORMATION FROM THE LIST AVAILABLE TO INDIVIDUALS REQUIRED TO FILE UNDER TITLE 4 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (C) UPON THE REQUEST OF THE COMMISSION, ANY OFFICIAL OR STATE AGENCY IN A TIMELY MANNER SHALL PROVIDE THE COMMISSION WITH ANY INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR THE COMMISSION TO PERFORM ITS FUNCTIONS UNDER THIS SECTION.
