CHAPTER 450

(House Bill 1645)

AN ACT concerning

Greation-of-a-State-Debt-- Energy Conservation and Solar Energy Program

FOR the purpose of permitting certain funds generated from the Energy Conservation and Solar Energy Program of 1981 to be used to provide financial assistance for energy conservation projects and solar energy projects and to provide-financial-cassistance-for-energy conservation-projects-and-solar-energy-projects-for commercial-buildings-and-to secure, establish reserves for, or pay the debt service on or the costs of issuance of bonds, notes or other obligations issued by the Community Development Administration or the Maryland Energy Financing Administration; and making this Act an emergency measure.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That chapter(s) of the Acts of the General Assembly read(s) as follows:
