CHAPTER 461

(House Bill 1785)

AN ACT concerning

Damages by Dogs

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Council of Baltimore County to prescribe the powers, duties, and responsible persons to implement a procedure that compensates inhabitants of Baltimore County for certain damages by dogs to sheep, poultry, or livestock; providing that certain moneys collected may be deposited in the general funds of Baltimore County; providing that the compensation may be paid from general funds of the county; and providing that any county may designate an official other than the sheriff to receive applications for compensation of certain damages by dogs; and generally relating to damages by dogs.
