be applied in construing the terms of an inter vivos trust. Whenever any of those statutory sections refer to a "will," "estate," or similar terms relevant primarily to wills and estates or the takers under them, the terms shall be modified to mean "trust instrument," "trust," or similar terms to reflect the application of the principles of those sections to inter vivos trusts.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 465

(House Bill 1851)

AN ACT concerning

Anchored Gill Nets - Aberdeen Proving Grounds

FOR the purpose of altering the exemption for the numbered commercial fishing areas in the Aberdeen Proving Grounds from certain restrictions as to the use of anchored gill nets.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Natural Resources Section 4-728(c) Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1981 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-728.

(c) (1) A person may not set an anchored gill net in the area of Chesapeake Bay bounded on the north by a line drawn from Turkey Point on the eastern shore to Sandy Point in Harford County, and on the south by a line drawn from Abbey Point to channel buoy Number 29, following the channel northward to buoy Number 1, off Grove Point, thence to Grove Point. This paragraph does not apply to the [numbered] commercial fishing [areas] AREA within the Aberdeen proving grounds as specified by the proving ground.
