- (b) "Hospice" means a facility that:
 - (1) PROVIDES A HOSPICE CARE PROGRAM; AND

- (3) Admits at least 2 but not more than 8 individuals who:
 - (i) Are unrelated; and
- (ii) Have no reasonable prospect of a cure; and
 - (iii) Are expected to die within 6 months.
