

UPON RECEIPT OF PROPER PROOFS PROOF OF THE DEATH OF THE PERSON WHO HAS ELECTED A VESTED RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AND DIES PRIOR TO HIS OR HER EFFECTIVE RETIREMENT DATE, THE AMOUNT OF THAT PERSON'S ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS SHALL BE PAID TO THE BENEFICIARY THE PERSON HAS NOMINATED BY WRITTEN DESIGNATION DULY EXECUTED AND FILED WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, OR IF THERE BE NO DESIGNATED BENEFICIARY, THEN TO THE PERSON'S ESTATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 508

(Senate Bill 272)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Error Correction and Obsolete Phrase Repeal

FOR the purpose of correcting certain errors and repealing certain obsolete phrases in the Pensions Article; and providing that this Act is not intended to affect any law other than to correct technical errors.
