- (d) With any municipal corporation;
- (e) As a postsecondary teacher;
- (F) WITH THE STATE GOVERNMENT; OR
- (G) WITH A PUBLIC SCHOOL AS A TEACHER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 511

(Senate Bill 286)

AN ACT concerning

State Use Industries - Audits

FOR the purpose of providing that the Legislative Auditor shall conduct audits of State Use Industries; providing for annual or biennial audits of a fiscal and compliance nature and for the advising of certain State Use Industries officials ~~under-certain-conditions~~ of the frequency of the audits; requiring State Use Industries to bear the cost of the fiscal portion of post audit examinations; and generally relating to the audit of State Use Industries.
