THESE REPORTS SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION ON DEMOGRAPHIC, DISABILITY, AND COST EFFECTIVENESS DATA, AS WELL AS RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE CONTINUATION OF THE PROGRAM.

THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL ADMINISTER THIS SUBTITLE, AND MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT IT.
