(2) IF THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE DESIGNATES A GOVERNMENT ACTIVITY AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNMENT ACTIVITY SHALL BE EVALUATED BY JULY 1 OF:

(I) THE SECOND YEAR FOLLOWING THE YEAR IN WHICH THE DESIGNATION IS MADE; OR

(II) ANY OTHER YEAR THAT THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE DETERMINES.
