7-307. PLACEMENT PLAN.

(A) "PLACEMENT" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "PLACEMENT" MEANS AN ARRANGEMENT THAT THE DIRECTOR MAKES FOR THE SUPERVISED CARE OF A MENTALLY RETARDED INDIVIDUAL IN A FACILITY, INCLUDING A FOSTER HOME, BOARDING HOME, OR RESIDENT EMPLOYMENT.

(B) PLAN REQUIRED.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL PREPARE A PLAN FOR THE PLACEMENT OF THE RESIDENTS OF EACH STATE FACILITY IN THE LEAST RESTRICTIVE SETTING.

(C) CONTENTS OF PLAN.

- (1) THE PLACEMENT PLAN SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING PARTS.
- (2) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 1982, THERE SHALL BE A PART THAT, ON THE BASIS OF THE INDIVIDUAL PLANS OF TREATMENT OF THE RESIDENTS OF STATE FACILITIES, ASSESSES THE NUMBER OF RESIDENTS WHO MAY FUNCTION APPROPRIATELY IN A LESS RESTRICTIVE FACILITY.
- (3) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 1983, THERE SHALL BE A PART THAT:
- (I) ASSESSES THE NUMBER, TYPE, AND LOCATION OF ALTERNATIVE FACILITIES THAT ARE NEEDED IN A COMMUNITY FOR THE HABILITATION OF THESE RESIDENTS;
- (II) LISTS, IN DETAIL, THE RESOURCES AND PROCEDURES THAT ARE NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH THE ALTERNATIVE FACILITIES; AND
- (III) ANALYZES THE FEASIBILITY OF TRANSFERRING RESOURCES OF A STATE FACILITY TO A COMMUNITY FACILITY.
- (4) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 1984, THERE SHALL BE A PART THAT:
- (I) SUMMARIZES THE INDIVIDUAL PLANS OF TREATMENT;
- (II) PROPOSES A SCHEDULE FOR THE RELOCATION OF RESIDENTS WHOSE INDIVIDUAL PLAN OF TREATMENT
