7-311. BOARDS -- MEMBERSHIP.

- (A) COMPOSITION; APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.
- (1) EACH BOARD CONSISTS OF 7 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
- (2) THE BOARD FOR EACH STATE FACILITY SHALL REFLECT ADEQUATELY THE COMPOSITION OF THE COMMUNITY THAT THE STATE FACILITY SERVES.
- . (3) OF THE 7 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FOR A STATE FACILITY:
- (I) AT LEAST 2 SHALL BE PARENTS OR OTHER RELATIVES OR GUARDIANS OF RESIDENTS OF THAT STATE FACILITY; AND
- (II) EACH OF THE OTHERS SHALL BE INDIVIDUALS WHO:
- 1. ARE KNOWN FOR THEIR INTEREST IN CIVIC AND PUBLIC AFFAIRS; AND
- 2. HAVE EXPRESSED AN ACTIVE INTEREST IN THE CARE OF MENTALLY RETARDED INDIVIDUALS OR GENERALLY IN MENTAL RETARDATION ENDEAVORS.
- (4) THE COVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS FROM A LIST OF QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE SECRETARY. THE NUMBER OF NAMES ON THE LIST SHALL BE AT LEAST TWICE THE NUMBER OF VACANCIES.
