~~-(4)- (IV)~~ Details of any contractual relationship with the State or a State agency, including the subject matter and the consideration.

~~-(5)- (V)~~ Details of any transaction with the State involving a monetary consideration, excluding those enumerated by the Committee in the guidelines established pursuant to this title.

~~(2) FOR PURPOSES OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMITTEE MAY ADOPT PROCEDURES TO KEEP CONFIDENTIAL THE NAME OF THE PERSON REPRESENTED.~~

City of Baltimore - General Powers

FOR the purpose of altering the maximum fine which may be provided for the violation of any ordinance, rule or regulation established by Baltimore City.
