Article II - General Powers

(48)

To provide penalties for the violation of any ordinance, rule or regulations established by the City under or in the execution of any power granted by this Article II; provided that no fine shall exceed [\$500.00] \$1,000 and no imprisonment shall be for a longer period than 12 months.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

AN ACT concerning

Mental Hygiene - Procedures and Hearing for Admission

FOR the purpose of providing for procedures relating to the admission or release of an individual to a facility operated by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; providing for a hearing under certain circumstances; providing that the hearing be conducted within a certain time in a certain manner; providing that the hearing officer consider certain elements as to the individual whose admission is sought; clarifying language; and generally relating to circumstances and procedures regarding admission to certain facilities.
