FUNDS ALLOCATED FOR LAND ACQUISITIONS UNDER PROGRAM OPEN SPACE MAY NOT BE UTILIZED FOR ACQUISITION OF ANY SITES WHICH HAVE NOT COMPLETED FINAL SETTLEMENT AND WHICH HAVE BEEN OR ARE THE SUBJECT OF ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES ARTICLE, § 8-1413.2 OR THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ARTICLE, § 7-232, UNLESS ANY ILLEGALLY DISPOSED HAZARDOUS WASTES HAVE BEEN REMOVED, CONTAINED, OR OTHERWISE CONTROLLED AS REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
