

CHAPTER 542

(Senate Bill 617)

AN ACT concerning

State Police - Modified Work Week

FOR the purpose of authorizing Maryland State Police law enforcement employees to work a modified work week of a certain number of work days and work hours other than the traditional work week; permitting the Maryland State Police to implement an alternative work schedule on a pilot basis for a certain period of time to provide adequate opportunity for implementation and evaluation; and providing for overtime compensation after a certain number of hours in that altered work week.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 88B - State Police

23B.

(A) IF AUTHORIZED BY A SUPERVISOR THE SUPERINTENDENT,
A LAW ENFORCEMENT EMPLOYEE OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE MAY
SHALL WORK A 10 HOUR WORK DAY AND 4 DAY WORK WEEK IN LIEU OF
AN 8 HOUR WORK DAY AND 5 DAY WORK WEEK.
