

(F) THE BOARD MAY ACT ON THIS APPLICATION OF AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF LEGAL EXPENSES WITHOUT A PRIOR HEARING. EITHER THE BOARD OR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY REQUIRE AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE SEEKING REIMBURSEMENT TO ANSWER QUESTIONS UNDER OATH AND PROVIDE ANY INFORMATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE MATTERS WHICH WERE THE SUBJECT OF THE INVESTIGATION OR CHARGES. ~~REFUSAL--TO--ANSWER ANY--QUESTION--OR--PROVIDE--INFORMATION--MAY--PROVIDE--GROUNDS--FOR DENIAL--OF--REIMBURSEMENT--~~

(G) IF THE BOARD DECLINES TO APPROVE REIMBURSEMENT IN WHOLE OR IN PART FOR ANY REASON IT SHALL STATE THE REASONS FOR THE DISAPPROVAL IN WRITING. A DETERMINATION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR DECISION OF THE BOARD UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW.

(H) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS MAY GRANT FROM THE GENERAL EMERGENCY FUND OR FROM FUNDS PROVIDED FOR THIS PURPOSE BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE BUDGET BILL OR FROM FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR THIS PURPOSE TO THE STATE INSURANCE TRUST FUND A SUM TO SATISFY AN AWARD OF REIMBURSEMENT OF ATTORNEY FEES UNDER THIS SECTION.

(I) THE STATE HAS A RIGHT OF SUBROGATION IN THE AMOUNT OF THE REIMBURSEMENT AS TO THE PROCEEDS OF ANY MONETARY JUDGMENT RECOVERED BY THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE IN A SUIT BROUGHT FOR FALSE ARREST OR MALICIOUS PROSECUTION OR ANY OTHER PROCEEDING ARISING OUT OF THE MATTERS INVOLVED IN THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION OR CHARGES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
