AN ACT concerning

Education - Parent Surrogates

FOR the purpose of defining certain terms dealing with parent surrogates; granting public agencies authority to request parent surrogates for certain children; giving the State Superintendent of Schools authority to appoint a parent surrogate in certain circumstances; allewing requiring the State Board of Education to adopt certain bylaws; granting limited immunity from suits for civil damages filed by and on behalf of the child entrusted to a parent surrogate; and generally relating to the appointment of educational parent surrogates.
