7-406. INVESTIGATION OF APPLICANT.

WHEN AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE IS FILED, THE ADMINISTRATION PROMPTLY SHALL INVESTIGATE THE APPLICANT.

7-407. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the second sentence of former Article 59A, § 20(d), except for the second clause of that sentence, which related to private group homes.

Although former Article 59A, § 20(d) provided for the issuance of a license to an applicant who meets the "requirements of its rules and regulations", this section is revised to cover additional statutory requirements of this subtitle.

7-408. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

A LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO OPERATE A PRIVATE FACILITY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.
