## Preamble

WHEREAS,-It-has-been-and-will-continue-to-be-the-policy of-this-State-to-authorize-the-counties,-municipalities,-and Baltimore-Sity-to-supplant-competition-by-granting-cable television-franchises-that-may-be-exclusive-in-nature, imposing-franchise-fees,-and-establishing-the-rates-charged to-customers-by-franchises,-now,-therefore,

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the following principles are adopted as a statement of the legislative policy of this State in regard to the regulation of community antenna television and cable television franchising:
