

an oath, as provided in the Constitution of Maryland, to faithfully perform the duties entrusted to him. The inspector shall visit and inspect at unannounced times every licensed premises in Frederick County at least every 90 days. The inspector shall make monthly reports in writing to the license commissioner covering his activities, setting forth any complaints, violations that may have been observed by him or reported to him. A person may not accept appointment or continue as an inspector if either he or any member of his immediate family has any personal or financial interest either directly or indirectly in any license or in any licensed premises under the provisions of this article. The County Commissioners of Frederick County shall provide the alcoholic beverages inspector an office, a part-time secretary of his own choosing, and an expense account to be determined by the County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
