 - (B) "UNDEREMPLOYED" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL:
- (1) WORKING PART TIME BUT SEEKING FULL-TIME WORK; OR
- (2) WORKING FULL TIME BUT RECEIVING WAGES BELOW THE GREATER OF:
- (I) THE POVERTY LEVEL DETERMINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ADMINISTRATION; OR
- (II) 70 PERCENT OF THE LOWER LIVING STANDARD INCOME LEVEL AS DETERMINED BY THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS.
- (C) "UNEMPLOYED" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WITHOUT A JOB, AND WHO WANTS AND IS AVAILABLE FOR WORK.
