SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 88A - Social Services Administration

(e) (1) The bureau may certify to the Comptroller any person whose court-ordered support obligations are more than 60 days in arrears. The certification may be made annually. The obligor shall be notified of the certification and the right of immediate appeal to the Income Maintenance Administration in the manner and form prescribed by regulation.

(2) The certification shall include the following information, if known:

(i) The full name and address of the obligor, and any other names known to be used by that person.

(ii) The social security number of the obligor.

(iii) The amount of accumulated arrearage of the support obligation.

(3) This subsection [does not apply unless:] APPLIES IF THE OBLIGOR IS MORE THAN 60 DAYS BEHIND IN SUPPORT PAYMENTS AS REQUIRED BY THE MOST RECENT COURT ORDER; AND

[(i) The person caring for the obligor's child or children is receiving aid to families with dependent children payments;
