SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

~~(A) (1) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:~~

~~(2) "SENIOR-CITIZEN" MEANS ANY RESIDENT OF THIS STATE WHO IS 60 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, OR WHO IS RETIRED AND/OR DISABLED AS DEFINED BY THE SOCIAL SECURITY OR RAILROAD RETIREMENT ACT.~~

~~(3) "INSTITUTION" MEANS ANY PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IN THIS STATE CERTIFIED BY THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.~~

~~(4) "TUITION" MEANS THE BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL CHARGE AND DOES NOT INCLUDE FEES, SUCH AS THOSE FOR REGISTRATION, APPLICATION, OR LABORATORY WORK.~~

~~(B) AN INSTITUTION SHALL ADMIT A SENIOR CITIZEN TO ANY SCHEDULED SESSION AND WAIVE THE TUITION INVOLVED.~~

~~(1) AFTER THE REGISTRATION PERIOD HAS BEEN COMPLETED,~~

~~(2) ONLY WHEN REGULARLY SCHEDULED COURSE SPACE IS AVAILABLE,~~

~~(3) FOR ANY CREDIT OR NONCREDIT COURSE, AND~~

~~(4) FOR AS MANY AS 3 COURSES PER TERM.~~

~~(C) AT THE TERMINATION OF EACH REGISTRATION PERIOD, THE INSTITUTION SHALL FURNISH TO THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER~~
