amount required to meet the current disbursements of these allowances.

- (B) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
- (I) AN OFFICIAL ELECTED-OR-APPOINTED INITIALLY ELECTED OR INITIALLY APPOINTED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1982;
- (II) A MEMBER PROMOTED TO AN UNCLASSIFIED POSITION ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1982; OR
- (III) A MEMBER WHOSE TENURE IS TERMINATED BY AN ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1982.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 622

(House Bill 488)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Disability Retirement

FOR the purpose of requiring persons who retire after a certain date and are receiving disability benefits under the State retirement or pension systems to provide certain information to the board of trustees; and providing that persons who refuse to provide the information shall have their retirement allowance suspended for a certain period.
