Administrators, the State Board of Examiners in Optometry, the State Board of Pharmacy, the State Board of Medical Examiners, the Commission on Medical Discipline, the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists, and the Health Services Cost Review Commission in accordance with the provisions of the Regulatory Programs Evaluation Act of 1978 by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of these boards.
