- 1. TO UNDERTAKE ANY TRAINING IN
ACUPUNCTURE PRIOR TO ENGAGING IN THE SUPERVISION OF
ACUPUNCTURE; AND
- 2. IN ANY CALENDAR YEAR TO TAKE MORE
THAN 25 PERCENT OF THE PHYSICIAN'S CATEGORY I CONTINUING
MEDICAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENT IN ACUPUNCTURE.

(III) THE TRAINING REQUIREMENT PROVIDED IN
SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH MAY NOT BECOME EFFECTIVE
UNTIL A PROGRAM OF TRAINING IN ACUPUNCTURE FOR SUPERVISING,
LICENSED PHYSICIANS, APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND ACCREDITED
FOR CATEGORY I CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION, EXISTS IN THIS
STATE.

(2) OF THE 5 MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL:

- (I) 2 SHALL BE LICENSED PHYSICIANS; AND
- (II) 3 SHALL BE ACUPUNCTURISTS WHO ARE NOT
LICENSED PHYSICIANS.

(3) THE LICENSED PHYSICIAN MEMBERS OF THE
COUNCIL SHALL:

- (I) HAVE ENGAGED REGULARLY IN THE
SUPERVISION OF ACUPUNCTURE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS BEFORE
APPOINTMENT; AND
