(A) IN CAROLINE COUNTY A CLASS A BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR LICENSEE MAY NOT ALLOW PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 TO ENGAGE IN POOL, BILLIARDS, SHUFFLEBOARD, OR THE PLAYING OF PINBALL OR CONSOLE MACHINES, OR IN ANY OTHER GAME OF CHANCE OR SKILL IN THE LICENSED ESTABLISHMENT UNLESS THOSE PERSONS UNDER 18 ARE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.

(B) A LICENSEE, ON INDICTMENT AND CONVICTION OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$50 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 30 DAYS, OR BOTH.

(a) The several boards of license commissioners herewith are authorized and empowered to issue the alcoholic beverages licenses provided for by this article in their respective jurisdictions.

(F-1) (1) IN CAROLINE COUNTY, THE COUNTY CODES ADMINISTRATOR IS THE INSPECTOR FOR THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

(2) THE SALARY OF THE INSPECTOR SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE COUNTY BUDGET. THE DUTIES OF THE INSPECTOR SHALL BE AS SPECIFIED BY THE BOARD, INCLUDING THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LAWS OF CAROLINE COUNTY.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
