and thereafter shall be credited on the books of the State Comptroller and expended, upon approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees: for a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the construction, renovation, improvement, and equipping equipment of Memorial Stadium on 33rd Street in the City of Baltimore.

(4) There is hereby levied and imposed an annual State tax on all assessable property in the State in rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and when due and until paid in full, such principal to be discharged within fifteen years of the date of issue of the bonds.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1982.

## CHAPTER 663

(House Bill 919)

AN ACT concerning

## Creation of a State Debt -Maryland Science Center

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$750,000 \$500,000, the proceeds to be used for a grant to the Maryland Academy of Sciences for alteration, expansion, improvement, and renovation of the Maryland Science Center in Baltimore City, subject to the requirement that the Maryland Academy of Sciences provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland Science Center Loan of 1982 in the aggregate principal amount of \$750,000 \$500,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
