

shall maintain its fiscal effort on either a per student basis or on an aggregate basis for vocational education, compared with the amount expended in the previous fiscal year, to be eligible to receive its vocational-technical set-aside from basic current expense aid.

(2) The vocational-technical set-asides from basic current expense aid for each subdivision are:
