Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

11-504.

(b) The following items are exempt from execution on a judgment.

(5) ~~\$3,000-for-property~~ PROPERTY of any kind equivalent in value to \$3,000-+- IS AUTOMATICALLY EXEMPT, UNLESS WITHIN 15 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE LEVY BY THE SHERIFF, THE DEBTOR ELECTS, IN LIEU OF CASH, ~~TO EXEMPT ANY PART OF THE DEBTOR'S--PROPERTY--OF--ANY--KIND~~ PROPERTY, TO EXEMPT CASH IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED A VALUE OF \$3,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
