(2) mentally retarded and other developmentally disabled individuals on community waiting lists shall comprise 60 percent.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 723

(House Bill 1513)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Historic Annapolis

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$600,000, the proceeds to be used to assist Historic Annapolis, Inc. to preserve-and-restore historic-buildings purchase and restore the Brice House, 42 East Street in Annapolis, subject to the requirement that Historic Annapolis, Inc. provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain type for the same purpose by a certain date; encouraging Historic Annapolis, Inc. to make the Brice House self-supporting; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Historic Annapolis, Inc. Loan of 1982 in the aggregate principal amount of \$600,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement, as amended from time to time).
- (2) The bonds issued to evidence this loan or installments thereof may be sold as a single issue, or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under § 2B of Article 31 of the Code.
- (3) The actual cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and shall be first applied to
