

educational, recreational, or library purposes. The use of the property may not be contingent upon payment of a rental fee or other compensation unless the fee or other compensation is used by the association solely for improvement or maintenance of the property.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

CHAPTER 760

(House Bill 1914)

AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Budget and Finance

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Carroll County Commissioners to establish a fund for self insurance of county property; providing that the Commissioners may set certain limits on the fund; providing that the annual county appropriations shall make certain reimbursements to the fund; enumerating what moneys are included in the Carroll County surplus fund; ~~authorizing--a--reserve--fund--for--permanent--public improvements--to--be--funded--from--a--specific--source; delineating--certain--procedures--for--public--hearings before--any--expenditure--is--made--from--the--reserve--fund for--permanent--public--improvements; providing that the~~ reserve fund be used for a certain purpose; and generally relating to budgeting and financial considerations in Carroll County.
