(House Bill 1920)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Revenue Bonds
for Residential Mortgages

FOR the purpose of authorizing Anne Arundel County to borrow money and issue revenue bonds for the purpose of financing the purchase of dwellings by persons with certain income limitations, and providing certain legislative findings and legislative purposes, and generally relating to the authority and procedures by which Anne Arundel County may issue revenue bonds to finance certain dwelling purchases.
