

(1) "Low and moderate income persons and families" means persons and families determined by a county to lack the financial ability to pay prices or rentals sufficient to induce private enterprise in the county to build a sufficient supply of adequate, safe, and sanitary dwellings without the special assistance afforded by this section.

(2) "County" means a county that has adopted the optional powers of home rule provided under Article XI-F of the Constitution and [Washington County] ANNE ARUNDEL AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Participation in the Optional Retirement Program

FOR the purpose of allowing certain members of the Employees' Retirement System and the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland to participate in the Optional Retirement Program; and making certain corrective and technical changes.
