SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

Washington Suburban Sanitary District - Area Laws and
Boundary Descriptions
PG/MC 35-82

FOR the purpose of transferring the boundaries and certain special provisions of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District from the Annotated Code to the Session Laws; providing that the boundaries of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District are as found in the Session Laws; and generally relating to the boundaries and area laws of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, and transferring
