(a) The area herein described is hereby added to the Washington Suburban Sanitary District created by chapter 122 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1918: All that area in the Gaithersburg, Laytonsville and Olney election districts of Montgomery County, Maryland, lying within the following described boundaries: Beginning for the same at a point on the existing boundary of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District, that point being west of and 1,000 feet distant from the west line of the Gaithersburg-Laytonsville Road and 500 feet northeast of the east line of the road leading from Redland to Pratherstown and running thence in a northerly direction, west of, parallel to and 1,000 feet distant from the west line of the Gaithersburg-Laytonsville Road, Route 124, approximately 9,500 feet to the south right of way line of the Potomac Electric Power Company's transmission line, thence in an easterly direction with the south right of way line of the transmission line to a point, 500 feet northeast of and at right angles to the northeast line of the Laytonsville-Olney Road, Route 108, thence in a southeasterly direction, northeast of, parallel to and 500 feet distant from the northeast line of the Laytonsville-Olney Road, Route 108, approximately 14,000 feet to the existing boundary of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District, thence in a southwesterly, southerly and northwesterly direction with the existing boundary of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District to the point of beginning.

(b) The jurisdiction of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission is hereby extended to include the area above described and the area shall be subject to all the rules and regulations of the commission and all provisions of law relating to the district, including taxes and other sums or charges levied by such commission in other parts of the district.
