Fisher, trustee, to Richard D. LaGarde, dated February 12, 1944, and recorded among the aforesaid land records in liber 930 at folio 278, thence in a northeasterly and southeasterly direction reversely with and along the first and part of the fourth lines of the aforesaid deed recorded in liber 930 at folio 278, to the end of the sixth or south $13^{\circ} 27' 15''$ west, 1522.95 foot line of a deed from Mary P. Bradley, unmarried, to Richard D. LaGarde, et ux, dated November 9, 1937, and recorded among the aforesaid land records in liber 685 at folio 194, thence in a northerly direction reversely with and along the sixth line of the aforesaid deed recorded in liber 685 at folio 194 to a point, south of, at right angles to and 300 feet distant from the south line of Tuckerman Lane, thence in a northwesterly direction southwest of, parallel to and 300 feet distant from the southwest line of Tuckerman Lane to the existing boundary of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District, thence in a northerly, easterly, southerly, northwesterly and southwesterly direction with the existing boundary of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District to the point of beginning.

(b) The jurisdiction of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission is hereby extended to include the area above described and that area shall be subject to all the rules and regulations of the commission and all provisions of law relating to the district, including taxes and other sums or charges levied by the commission in other parts of the district.
