

(1) EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL ON PREVENTION AND TREATMENT OF ALCOHOLISM AND REHABILITATION OF ALCOHOLICS; AND

(2) EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL ON THE PROBLEMS OF INTOXICATION AND ALCOHOLISM IN THIS STATE FOR USE IN A PROGRAM TO PREVENT THE EXCESSIVE AND ABUSIVE USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
