COMMITTEE NOTE: The last 3 sentences of former Article 67, § 3-13(a), which provided certain exemptions for master plumbers and certain license requirements for other persons, are deleted as unnecessary and obsolete.

[(b) Any person, firm or corporation failing to comply with the provisions of this section or violating the regulations adopted hereunder by the commission shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable, as are other misdemeanors under this article, as specified in section 18-7.]

TITLE 4. BONDS AND ANTICIPATION NOTES GENERALLY.

[4-1] 4-101. Authority to issue bonds; form; exemption for taxation; signatures and seal; guaranty of payment; funds to service bonds for buildings; audits.

(a) For the purpose of providing funds for the design, construction, reconstruction, establishment, extension, enlargement, purchase or condemnation of the water, sewerage and drainage systems in the sanitary district, or in any other areas where extension of any of the aforementioned systems may be authorized by law, or for the construction, remodeling, enlargement or replacement of any office or operating building or buildings required for the administration or operation of any of the systems, including the acquisition of land or equipment, the [commission] WSSC is authorized and empowered to issue bonds of the sanitary district, from time to time, in such amounts as it may deem necessary to carry on its work, but the aggregate amount of bonds heretofore or hereafter issued under this section which may be outstanding at any time, less the amount held in the joint sinking fund account for the payment of the principal of the bonds, shall not exceed [fourteen per centum (]14[%)]] PERCENT of the total assessable basis of all property assessed for county taxation purposes within the sanitary district; provided, however, that in computing the amount of bonds which may be issued under this section, there shall not be included any bonds heretofore or hereafter issued for the payment of which the [commission] WSSC is required by law to fix and collect water service charges at least sufficient to pay the principal and interest requirements of such bonds. Bonds hereafter issued
