not less than two issues in any newspaper published in Prince George's County, that the commission has under consideration construction of a drainage system in the area determined upon or part of the area, giving in the advertisement the approximate cost and the general area affected, and advising those interested that a hearing will be held by the county at a time and place named in the advertisement at which all interested parties will be heard. At the hearing the commission shall be prepared to exhibit a plan for the drainage area or part of the area, including the length and size of pipe and the approximate cost.

(C) (1) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, IF SURFACE WATER OR STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES ARE INCLUDED IN THE WSSC CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM, PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL ADVERTISE IN AT LEAST 2 NEWSPAPERS PUBLISHED IN THE COUNTY.

## (2) THE ADVERTISEMENT SHALL INCLUDE:

- (I) NOTICE THAT THE WSSC HAS PROPOSED THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SURFACE WATER OR STORM DRAINAGE SYSTEM;
- (II) THE APPROXIMATE COST AND GENERAL LOCATION OF THE PROPOSED SYSTEM;
- (III) NOTICE THAT INTERESTED PARTIES MAY BE HEARD AT A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED SYSTEM; AND
- (IV) NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE HEARING.
- (3) THE WSSC SHALL BE PREPARED TO EXHIBIT A PLAN FOR SURFACE WATER OR STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES AT THE HEARING. THE EXHIBIT SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION ABOUT THE LENGTH AND SIZE OF PIPE AND THE APPROXIMATE COST OF THE PIPE.

[In its final action, the county governing body may make such amendments, revisions or modifications as it may determine, subject to the limitations otherwise herein provided.]

- (D) (1) EACH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY GOVERNING BODY SHALL APPROVE, DISAPPROVE, OR MODIFY THE WSSC CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM.
- (2) IN THEIR REVIEW OF THE WSSC CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM, EACH COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL SEEK THE ADVICE AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION.
- (3) EACH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY GOVERNING BODY MAY DESIGNATE A WATER OR SEWER MAIN FOR CONTROLLED OR LIMITED ACCESS FOR SERVICE TO DESIGNATED AREAS WITHIN THE RESPECTIVE COUNTY.
