8-314. OFFICERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, EACH COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL AND EACH INTERCOUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ELECT ANNUALLY A CHAIRMAN AND OTHER OFFICERS THAT THE COUNCIL FINDS NECESSARY.

(B) CHAIRMAN.

A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE AS CHAIRMAN FOR MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE YEARS.

(C) ELECTIONS.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE AS EACH COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL OR INTERCOUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL DETERMINES.

8-315. MEETINGS; STAFF SERVICES.

(A) MEETINGS.

(1) EACH COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL AND INTERCOUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE COUNCIL DETERMINES.

(2) THE ALCOHOLISM COORDINATOR FOR EACH COUNTY SHALL ATTEND AT LEAST ONE MEETING A YEAR OF THE COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL OR INTERCOUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL.

(B) STAFF SERVICES.

STAFF SERVICES FOR EACH COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL OR INTERCOUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY.
