

Manicurists - Scope of Practice - Renewal Fees

FOR the purpose of allowing a holder of a certificate as a manicurist to practice beauty--culture his or her profession at certain locations; ~~eliminating--the requirement--that--a--holder--of--a--certificate--as--a manicurist--practice--beauty--culture--at--a--registered beauty--shop; and~~ clarifying which renewal fees a holder of a certificate as a manicurist is required to pay; ~~requiring--the--State--Board--of--Cosmetologists--to--refund certain--fees--paid--by--certain--manicurists;--and--making stylistic--corrections.~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter ____ (H.B. 523) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1982) read(s) as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

483.

(A) No person shall be permitted by the Board to take an examination to receive a certificate as a manicurist unless the person is at least 17 years of age, and has completed not less than 100 hours of instruction in that practice in a beauty school duly registered by the Board, or has served as an apprentice under the supervision of a licensed manicurist in an approved beauty shop for a period of not less than three months.

(B) The holder of a special certificate shall engage only in the limited practice of the art of beauty culture authorized by the special certificate.
